CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

“Say unceasingly this chaplet that I have taught you. Anyone who says it will receive great Mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as the last hope. Even the most hardened sinner, if he recites this Chaplet even once, will receive grace from My Infinite Mercy. I want the whole world to know My Infinite Mercy. 1. Using normal rosary beads, begin with:

Our Father..., Hail Mary..., Apostles Creed.

2. On the five large beads:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ
In atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

3. On the ten small beads:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion
Have mercy on us and on the whole world.
(Repeat steps two and three for all decades)

4. At the end of the Divine Mercy Chaplet repeat three times:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One,
have mercy on us and on the whole world.

APOSTLES CREED
