### **MASS ATTENDANCE: All Catholics are required to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.**

For those students who are preparing to receive a Sacrament (First Penance, First Holy Communion, or Confirmation), a "**Mass Attendance Slip**" is required to be placed in the collection basket during Mass. Those families who attend Mass elsewhere may turn in a bulletin from the visited church. Please be sure that the student(s) name(s) and class day/grade is clearly listed for each student preparing to receive a sacrament.<sup>2</sup>

**CLASS SELECTION:** Please indicate on the front of this registration form, your class selections for each child. Children will be placed in classes on a **first come, first served** basis with preference given to registered parishioners. If your choice **cannot** be honored, the Religious Education Office **will contact you**. Due to space and time constraints, we may not be able to accommodate schedule changes due to sports or extracurricular activities.

### **Sacramental Preparation Program: First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Holy Communion**

Per diocesan policy, two years of preparation are required to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and Communion - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Children will receive their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion during their 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. *Parents of children making their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion will be **required** to attend mandatory meetings throughout the year. Children will be **required** to attend two (2) mandatory workshops throughout the year.*

### **Special Sacrament ("SPEC") Class: Baptism, First Reconciliation, and First Holy Communion**

For children in 3<sup>rd</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> grade who need to receive these sacraments. Please contact the RE Office for further information. *Parents of children making their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion will be **required** to attend mandatory meetings throughout the year. Children will be **required** to attend two (2) Mandatory workshops throughout the year.*

**RCIA Program** – High School age and above, please contact the Religious Education Office for more information.

Individuals and families interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith or who wish to become Catholic, please contact the RE Office to schedule an interview with the RE Director. Classes normally take place on Sunday evenings.
